

EMERGENCY AND FIRE SERVICES TECHNOLOGY – 3 Credits

Students enrolled in the Emergency and Fire Services program will experience the exciting world of Emergency Services first hand. This program will provide students with excellent insight into these fast-paced exciting careers.

The program is one year in length and is open to juniors, seniors, and adults (on a space available basis.) Upon successful completion of the program, students are eligible to test and become certified in all areas. Students are awarded certificates through West Virginia University Fire Service extension and RESA VIII. Opportunities exist for employment in Fire Science, Ambulance Services, Dispatching, Security Agencies and many other fields.

Students will receive actual training in the following subject areas:

Semester 1:

Fire Fighting 1 – period 1 or period 7 (90 hours) 220319

Fire Science Technology – periods 2 & 3 or periods 5 & 6 (180 hours) 220219

Semester 2:

Fire Fighting 2 – period 1 or period 7 (90 hours) 220529

EMT – Basic – periods 2 & 3 or periods 5 & 6 (180 hours) 220629
