

**HEALTH OCCUPATIONS SCIENCE TECHNOLOGY - 3 Credits ( Juniors and Seniors)**

PRE-ENROLLMENT RECOMMENDATIONS:

Class is open to Juniors and Seniors in Courses 1 and 2. Seniors only in Courses 3 and 4 after successful completion of Courses 1 and 2. Pre-registration is helpful. Contact guidance counselor for pre-registration packet.

1. Excellent attendance record.
2. Ability to read and comprehend to grade level.
3. Ability to successfully complete a general math course.
4. Knowledge of Anatomy and Physiology helpful.
5. Good spelling skills.

DESCRIPTION: Health Occupations provides training for students interested in making a career decision in the health care field. The class is open to Juniors and Seniors and is divided into four courses. A 2<sup>nd</sup> year senior may choose to explore one of the speciality areas of Geriatric Nursing Assistant, Veterinarian Assistant Aide, Physical/Restorative Aide or any one of several other health occupations. Students must maintain a “C” average in both Courses 1 and 2 before enrolling in Course 3 and 4. Course 4 is available to Seniors who have successfully completed Course 1, 2, and 3 with a “C” average. This is a work-based curriculum and skills introduced in this course are entry-level and prepare students for employment in a variety of health care settings.
