



Course Description // Welding Technology // 3 Credits

PREREQUISITES:

The student must be sufficiently mature and able to read and write on a 9th grade level and be able to use fractions and decimals. The student should have finger dexterity and spatial aptitude and should not be color blind. Excellent attendance record is recommended.

DESCRIPTION:

The Welding course is planned to give the student entry level skill in the welding field. The student will receive training in blueprint reading, metal fabrication, and welding theory. Shop training will consist of the following: shielded metal arc basic and advanced, oxygen ace welding and cutting, MIG welding, TIG welding, plasma arc cutting, and related metal working equipment.

Students completing the course will have an opportunity to take the West Virginia Welding Certification Test.
