- How to Apply:** Applicant is required to:
1. Fully complete and sign the attached application form (answering all questions) and obtain the signature of the program's instructor or the school principal in the space provided;
 2. Submit a personal letter to DAR (up to two letter-size pages) covering the four topics described in Section F of the application form;
 3. Provide one character reference from person of applicant's choice; and
 4. Meet the October 15, 2020, postmarking deadline. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
